# **CULTURAL CONTEXT**

... I am aware that I am in a cultural context which may be new to me. I am prepared to see, hear and experience things which may not correspond with the values and norms from my own cultural context, but I am open to this new context. I am interested in learning about the new cultural context I am in and will try my best to adapt to it. I understand that I am a guest in this context and I will deal respectfully with the culture(s) and ways of living of the different people I meet while I am here. I will do my best not to judge immediately. If I have a severe problem with something I see, hear or experience, I will do my best to address it in a respectful, constructive and appropriate way. I will do my best to carefully listen to and understand the other side.

# WORKING COMMITMENT TO UNCSO

... I am aware that I came to UNCSO to contribute something. While UNCSO will respect my free time before and after working hours, I realize that I have a working commitment and will respect it. It is self-evident for me that I prepare for my work, that I am on time for my work and that I treat the property of UNCSO with care. I will do my best to be a productive team player during my work, who addresses conflicts in a constructive manner and reliably cooperates with and reports to the Project Manager. I understand that as a volunteer I am part of UNCSO and represent it not only during my working hours. I am aware that people in Usakos (the children,

their parents, etc.) will associate me with UNCSO also during off-hours and I am willing to respect this and act in the organisation's best interest at all times.

### ALCOHOL, SMOKING AND DRUGS

...I am aware that alcohol is a problem in the community of Usakos and an issue many of the project's children have to deal with in one way or another. I am ready to respect this in such ways that I will never drink in front of the children, bring alcohol to the center or show up drunk there. I understand that as Usakos is a small town, I have to act responsibly during my free time in Usakos to be a role model/positive image to the children who I may also come across during non-working hours. It is also self-evident for me that as in any other job, it is a poor performance to show up with a hangover for work and I understand that in the particular case of working with children it is an absolute no go. Also with regard to smoking I will act as a role model towards the children. I understand that drugs are illegal in Namibia and will respect that.

#### WORKING WITH CHILDREN

...I am aware that working with children requires patience, determination, commitment and sensitivity and I am willing to apply these attributes to my best ability when working with the children. I am willing to do my best to understand the children's different concerns, to listen to them and to treat them respectfully. It is self-evident for me that the use of violence against children is an absolute no go. I am committed to act as a positive influence towards the children.

#### STAYING IN THE HOUSE OF THE PROJECT MANAGER

...I am aware that I am staying in the house of another family. I am willing to respect their way of living and property and I am open to be integrated into the procedures of the house. In relation to the first point of this memorandum (cultural context), I understand that some things may run differently in this house than they do at my home. I am open to learn, listen and adapt to the house rules and the culture of the family I stay with. Should any conflict come up, I am willing to address it in a constructive manner. It is self-evident for me that I clean after myself, that I treat any items I use with care, that I respect the private property of everybody I live with and that I generally conduct myself as a house mate I would like to live with myself.

As a volunteer, I hereby declare that I have carefully read the above, fully agree with it and will do my best to apply it. I understand that failure in conducting as per the above will have consequences and may result in the determination of my work for UNCSO.
